

COMMISSION HEARING

TORONTO, ONTARIO - AUGUST 28, 2012

IN THE MATTER OF THE RACING COMMISSION ACT S.O. 2000, c.20;

AND IN THE MATTER OF THE APPEAL AND REQUEST FOR HEARING BY STANDARDBRED LICENSEE AARON BYRON

On July 4, 2012, the Judges issued Official Ruling SB 44931 wherein Aaron Byron ("BYRON") was given a ten-day driving suspension for bearing in and causing an accident while driving the horse "K Aos Agent" during the running of the first race at Flamboro Downs on July 1, 2012. "K Aos Agent" finished in fourth position and was disqualified for causing an accident.

On July 12, 2012, BYRON filled a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 24.01 (b) of the Rules of Standardbred Racing.

On August 28, 2012, a Panel of the Ontario Racing Commission ("ORC"), comprised of Chair Rod Seiling, convened for the purpose of hearing this matter.

Brian Newton appeared on behalf of the Administration for the ORC. BYRON attended the hearing in person and was represented by Mike Sinclair.

Upon reviewing the evidence, and hearing the testimony of Senior Judge Chuck Fraleigh and driver J Brandon Campbell and reviewing the exhibits filed, BYRON requested an adjournment to obtain further exhibits. The Panel granted a continuance of the hearing to be rescheduled for September 13, 2012.

A transcript of the Panel's Oral Reasons for Decision is attached to this Ruling.
