

COMMISSION HEARING

TORONTO, ONTARIO - MAY 5, 2011

IN THE MATTER OF THE RACING COMMISSION ACT S.O. 2000, c.20;

AND IN THE MATTER OF THE APPEAL AND REQUEST FOR HEARING BY STANDARDBRED LICENSES NICK STEWARD & MARTIN O'TOOLE

On March 30, 2011, standardbred, driver Nick Steward, ("STEWARD") (ORC Licence Y2674), and owner Martin O'Toole ("O'TOOLE") (ORC Licence M95614) jointly appealed Judges' Ruling SB 43521 dated March 30, 2011, wherein STEWARD was fined \$300 for leaving the course and going inside a pylon and gaining an advantage in the 12th race, on March 28, 2011, at Western Fair Raceway, in violation of Rule 18.08.02 of the Rules of Standardbred Racing. Also appealed was Judges' Ruling SB 43522, the placing of the horse Justalittleluck from 1st to 4th, under Rule 22.09.

On May 5, 2011, a Panel of the Ontario Racing Commission ("ORC") consisting of Chair Rod Seiling, convened to hear the appeal.

Rick Rier appeared as agent for the Administration. STEWARD attended the hearing in person and was represented by Brian Tropea.

Upon hearing the testimony of Judge Wes Coke, and driver Nick Steward, upon reviewing the exhibits filed and, upon hearing the submissions of Rier and Tropea, the Panel dismissed both appeals.

A transcript of the Panel's Oral Decision is attached to this Ruling.
