  2. Reviewed break by #10 WHITE DANCER (Francis Picard) in the stretch, which was determined to have occurred after the finish. Clear.
  3. Inquiry and driver's objection #2 SAULSBROOK FLICKA (Michael Armstrong) against #7 AMERICAN ASSASSIN (Donald Jobin) after the ½ mile pole; Mr. Armstrong stated that #7 pushed him three wide which Mr. Jobin stated did not occur and was not supported by the video, objection disallowed. Clear.

  7. Inquiry on #2 THE BACK NINE (Marie-Claude Auger) in the stretch concerning AGCO rule 22.27 (breaking rule); #2 was off stride in the stretch and at the finish and was

lapped by #8 RED MONSTER, #3 finished 4<sup>th</sup> place 5<sup>th</sup> (AGCO rule 22.27 (c)); #2 qualifies for breaks (trainer notified).

Reviewed the start of #4 TLF BEWARE (Darrell Coville) who broke before and after the start, #4 had no broken equipment, was well inside the fair start pole and did receive a fair start; #4 qualifies for breaks (trainer notified). MASSIVE POTENTIAL #7 was a late Judges scratch (ineligible) as the owner did not have a valid AGCO licence, Refund: \$27. Clear.
