- Early Judges scratch (injured) of SOMETIMES WHEN from the seventh race by the AGCO veterinarian.
- Telephone review with driver Claude LaRose regarding his urging of TASK BAR HANOVER in the third race at Rideau on 9 July. Mr. LaRose was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.23.03 (b) (more than acceptable wrist action) and Policy Directive 3-2019 and was assessed a monetary penalty of \$200 and a driving suspension of three days (28-30 July, inclusive) (SB 1035788).
- Telephone review with driver Ryan Guy regarding his urging of ROCKING WIZARD in the fifth race at Kawartha Downs on 11 July 2020.
