For HORSES AGED 5 AND OVER, WHO ARE NON WINNERS OF \$3,000 IN 2021, and who have raced a MINIMUM OF 10 STARTS ON PEI in 2021. To be raced at Red Shores AT SUMMERSIDE RACEWAY.

1. DECLARATIONS DUE BY Thursday , OCTOBER 21st BY 9:00 a.m. Those DECLARING horses to these events are responsible for eligibility. ELIGIBILITY DETERMINED BY STARTS AND MONEY EARNINGS AS OF Thursday OCTOBER 21 st AT 9:00 A.M.
2. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet.
3. NO nomination and starting fees.
4. Minimum of Eight (8) DECLARATIONS ARE Required to fill this EVENT. If less than 8 DECLARATIONS are received the event may proceed at the discretion of Red Shores.
5. If 9 TO 16 declarations are received, HORSES WILL RACE IN one of TWO divisions, WHICH WILL BE HELD AT A DISTANCE OF ONE MILE.
6. If 17 to 24 declarations are received, horses will race in one of Three divisions, which will be held AT A DISTANCE OF ONE MILE.
7. Horses not earning purse money in the Division(s) AND/OR THE CONSOLATION will receive a \$75 Hook up fee.
8. There will be nine starters in the Final. If two divisions are held, the top four (4) place finishers from the two divisions plus the fastest fifth place finisher will advance to the Final. If three divisions are held , the first three (3) place finishers from the three divisions will advance to the Final.
9. The Final will race a distance of a mile and one sixteenth (1 1/16th), with a field of up to nine (9) starters.
10. Horses finishing 6th to 9th in the FINAL WILL RECEIVE A \$150 HOOK UP FEE.
11. In the event that there is a consolation, horses that earn enough money in the series to qualify for the final cannot race in the consolation.
12. IF SUFFICIENT ENTRIES ARE RECEIVED to fill both a horse and gelding and mares event, entries will be separated by sex. Otherwise, horses, geldings, and mares will race together.
13. In the event of a tie, the entry will be selected by lot.
14. All races will be at a distance of 1 mile unless otherwise stated.
15. Post positions for all events will be drawn by the Standardbred Canada Electronic Draw.
16. All events and race conditions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
17. Red Shores reserves the right to rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an APHRC approved future race date. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
18. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.

19. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores.
20. SHOULD there be horses with common ownership; Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per APHRC Rule 206.
21. If there is more than one division of the preliminary leg, each division will race for 100% of the advertised purse.
22. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 — 25 — 12 — 8 — 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 — 25 — 15 — 10%;
 - c. 3 starters: 60 — 30 — 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 — 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%.
