Judges received a call after Race 1 that driver Ross Battin was seen one-handing his horse after the wire on the video feed that went out to the public. After reviewing the postrace footage, it was confirmed that Mr. Battin did put both lines in his inside hand and make a striking motion toward his horse with his whip hand after the race. Mr Battin told the judges that he felt the horse was pulling up and that he hit him once. No placing was required as the violation occurred after the finish, but Mr Battin was issued a \$200 monetary penalty and a 3 day driving suspension for a first offense urging violation. AGCO Rule 22.23.01(a). Ruling # 1985611.
