Race 3 – Reviewed the drive of James Macdonald on the 3-5 favourite, #10 Bar Down Jim. The horse gets away 7th and is the first horse to move to the outside at the half. As #10 advances in the third quarter, three other horses move to the outside and #10 ends up fourth-over turning for home. #10 closes in the stretch to finish 2nd. The Panel did not feel Mr. Macdonald was in violation of any driving rules.

Race 4 – Inquiry – Reviewed the start of #9 Tour Champion (Jody Jamieson) for possible broken equipment. The Apex video shows the overcheck of #9 breaks after the start. All horses received a fair start; #9 was charted with BE.

Page 2 Race 5 – Reviewed the breaks by #2 Swan Trixie (Sylvain Filion) and #4 HP Mama B (LP Roy). Both horses lost a shoe and were charted with broken equipment.

Race 6 – All Clear

- #2 Back To The Future (Scott Young) finished the race with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 7 – Inquiry – Reviewed a possible pylon violation by #4 The Longest Yard (Austin Sorrie) around the final turn, finished 4th. The video shows #4 races inside two consecutive pylons but is forced inside by #2 Ario Hanover (LP Roy), who is visibly running in on the turn. Sorrie stated the two horses were close to hooking wheels and he was inside the pylons to avoid #2 as that horse was coming down on him. As a result, #4 was charted with interference and no placing was necessary.
