Race 2: **Inquiry:** #4 Frenchy Hanover (A.Haughan), finished 2nd, made a break in the stretch and through the finish. No placing as the horse abided by all the AGCO breaking rules.

#4 Frenchy Hanover must qualify for breaks. (2 in a row on a fast track)

Reviewed breaks of #2 Fastnet Rock, finished 5th, and #7 Er Norma, finished 6th, no placings needed as both horses did not violate the AGCO breaking rules.

Race 3: #1 Ultimate Long Shot finished with broken equipment. (murphy blind)

Race 4: Clear.

Race 5: #4 Barzy (S.Coulter), finished 5th and was placed 6th for failing to continuously lose ground while on a break.

Race 9: #7 Lulus King (R.Desroche) and #8 Havurcakeneatitoo (M.Lachance) hooked wheels at the head of the stretch. #7 Lulus King finished 7th and was placed 6th, #8 Havurcakeneatitoo finished 6th and was placed 7th. Both horses were charted with interference. #9 Theportugueseunion (J.Gouveia), finished 5th, did go inside 3 consecutive pylons for safety while #7 and #8 were hooked, therefore #9 remained 5th.
