MIKE'S TOP 15 FAVOURITE CUP STATS

7,313.73 – Dollars per second won by Mantacular when he was paid \$814,750 for 1 minute, 51 and 2/5ths seconds of work in winning the richest Cup in 2004

153 – Trainers have made at least one start in the Cup (final). Three trainers were added to the list in 2011 when Erv Miller (2 starters), Ron Potter and Wayne Givens made their debut. Another 3 joined the list in 2012 when Jimmy Takter (2 starters), Jim Mulinix, and Virgil Morgan, Jr. sent out their first Cup starters. The newbies in 2013 are Danny Collins, Mark Austin, Robin Schadt and Tony Alagna (2 starters) which means that 6 of the 10 starters are "first-time" trainers.

138 – Profit in dollars on a \$2 win bet on each of the 99 Cup starters that were 25-1 or higher. An investment of \$198 would have returned \$336 or a profit of \$138. The winners at odds of 25-1 or higher were: Quite A Sensation (\$63.50) in 1986, Goalie Jeff (\$93.60) in 1989, Safely Kept (\$63.70) in 1992, Straight Path (\$60.10) in 1998, and Mantacular (\$55.10) in 2004.

94.69 – Dollars per foot traveled that will be paid to the 2013 winner (\$500,000 for one mile or 5,280 feet)

40 – Starters with a "one word" name. Of those 40, only Somebeachsomewhere, Mantacular and Sportswriter managed to win the Cup.

23 – Cups won by a Canadian-born driver. Mark O'Mara was the lone exception in the first 19 Cups. US-born drivers have won 5 of the last 9 Cups (Pierce-twice, Sears, Manzi, and Magee) but the Canadians have rebounded to win 5 of the last 6 (Jamieson-twice, MacDonald, MacDonnell, Waples).

15 – (of 29) Cup winners won their elimination (51%)

13 – Different trainers have won the Cup in the past 13 years. Brett Pelling is the last trainer to win his second Cup.

6 – Cup starters in 2013 are sired by a Cup winner: Vegas Vacation (by Bettors Delight); Apprenitice Hanover, Captaintreacherous and Sunshine Beach (by Somebeachsomewhere), Wake Up Peter (by Rockroll Hanover), and Twilight Bonfire (by The Panderosa).

6 – (of 19) Cup winners at Woodbine or Mohawk left from Post 5. (No Cup winner in the 7/8ths track era has come from Post 4, 8 or 10.)

3 – Cup winners had to pace last quarters under :27 seconds to win their elimination. That's 3 of the first 29 Cup winners! Well Said fired home in 26.2 to win his elim in 2009. Rockroll Hanover was home in :26.3 in his 2005 elim and The Panderosa flew home in :26 to take an elim in 1999. This year ALL 3 elimination winners had last quarters under 27 – Captaintreacherous (26.4), Fool Me Once (26.4), Vegas Vacation (26.2).

2 – Breeders Crown (2YO Colt Pace) winners came back to win the Cup at 3 (Bettors Delight in 2000/2001 and Well Said in 2008/2009). Rockin Amadeus won the 2012 Crown but failed to qualify for the 2013 Cup when 5th as the favourite in his elimination.

2 – (of 19) Cup winners at Woodbine or Mohawk led at the 1/4. (Rockroll Hanover and Cams Cardshark).

1 – Cup starter led at the 1/4 in :26 or faster AND WON. (Rockroll Hanover, 25.4)

0 – Horses have won the Woodrow Wilson at two and the Cup at three. Can Captaintreacherous overcome this "jinx"?

Eliminations

85 – Eliminations contested over 29 years (excluding 2013)

44 – Winning favourites from 85 eliminations (51%)

25 – Cup winners were less than 10-1 in their elimination

15 – Cup winners won their elimination (51%)

10 – Consecutive years that the FASTEST elimination winner did NOT win the Cup, ending in 2008 with Somebeachsomewhere. Prior to 2008 the last Cup winner who was also the fastest elimination winner was Gothic Dream in 1997. Well Said was the fastest of 4 elimination winners in 2009 and he DID come back to win the final. The fastest elim winner in 2010 was Rock N Roll Heaven and he wound up 4th as the 2-1 favourite in the Cup final. The fastest elim winner in 2011 was Powerful Mist and he finished 6th in the final. In 2012 the dubious honor fell to Sweet Lou who wound up 4th in the final.

8 – Cup winners were third in their elimination (27%)

6 – Cup winners were second in their elimination (20%)

3 – Cup winners were higher than 10-1 in their elimination. (Davids Pass was 10.75-1 in 1995; Total Truth was 10.60-1 in 2006; Thinking Out Loud was 39.80-1 when he was 3rd in 2012.)

2 – of the last 15 Cup champions were the fastest elimination winners in their respective years. (Somebeachsomewhere & Well Said). The fastest elimination winner in 2013 was Fool Me Once in 1:48.1.

Earnings & Purses

1,629,500 – Record purse won by Mantacular in 2004

1,431,692 – Highest earnings of a Cup starter (Die Laughing who was 3rd in 1991)

814,750 – Largest purse cheque (paid to M and L of Delaware Inc., owners of Mantacular in 2004)

357,900 – Lowest purse (1984)

20,350 – Lowest earnings of a Cup starter (Stagecraft Hanover was 9th in 1996)

17,895 – Smallest purse cheque (paid to the Estate of John Froehlich, owner of Farmsteads Fame who was 5th in the 1984 Cup final. However, Farmsteads Fame earned an additional \$9,543 for finishing 3rd in his elimination which in 1984 was contested on the same night as the final.)

9,750 – Purse of the inaugural Queen City Pace won by Timely Knight and Roger White in 1964. The Queen City Pace was discontinued after Ralph Hanover's win in 1983 and was replaced by the North America Cup in 1984.

7,313.73 – Dollars per second won by Mantacular when he was paid \$814,750 for 1 minute, 51 and 2/5ths seconds of work in winning the richest Cup in 2004

6,931.60 – Dollars per second won by Well Said when he was paid \$750,000 for 1 minute, 48 and 1/5th seconds of work in winning the fastest Cup in 2009.

145 – Starters have earned a purse cheque

94.69 – Dollars per foot traveled that will be paid to the 2013 winner (\$500,000 for one mile or 5280 feet)

7 – Millionaires have started in the Cup (from 261 total starters). Die Laughing (\$1,431,692) was 3rd in 1991; Presidential Ball (\$1,234,104) won in 1993; Mach Three (\$1,221,208) was 2nd in 2002; Jeremes Jet (\$1,205,542) was 6th in 2006; Bettors Delight (\$1,093,411) won in 2001; Allamerican Native (\$1,073,660) was 2nd in a dead-heat in 2003; and Western Hanover (\$1,030,057) was 2nd in 1992.

7 – Millionaires have started in the Cup (from 271 starters). Die Laughing (\$1,431,692) was 3rd in 1991; Presidential Ball (\$1,234,104) won in 1993; Mach Three (\$1,221,208) was 2nd in 2002; Jeremes Jet (\$1,205,542) was 6th in 2006; Bettors Delight (\$1,093,411) won in 2001;

Allamerican Native (\$1,073,660) was 2nd in a dead-heat in 2003; and Western Hanover (\$1,030,057) was 2nd in 1992.

5 – Cup winners retired with less than \$1 million: Legal Notice, Staff Director, Safely Kept, Arizona Jack, and Straight Path

0 – Millionaires contested the elims in 2012 or 2013.

0 – Dollars earned in the Cup by a number of prominent horses, including Camtastic who was 8th by 2 ¾ lengths in 1988; Beach Towel who broke and was 9th in 1990; Riyadh who was 6th at 14-1 in 1993; Red Bow Tie who was 7th at 6-1 in 1997; Royalfly Hanover who was 6th in 1999; Real Desire who faded to 9th in 2001, etc. Each of these horses went on to win between \$2 million and \$3 million.

29.40 – Lowest Triactor payoff (Cams Card Shark-Pacific Rocket-Magical Mike in 1994)

21.40 – Highest Place payoff (We Will See in 2010)

15.50 – Highest Show payoff (Road Machine in 1990)

14 – Cup favourites who were odds-on. Of those 14, only 8 won. A \$2 win bet on all 14 favourites who were 1-1 or less would have cost \$28.00 and returned \$27.20 for a loss of \$0.80

13 – Trainers won with their first Cup starter (John Hayes with Legal Notice, Dave Wall with Staff Director; R. Claire Porter with Quite A Sensation; Mark O'Mara with Jate Lobell; Alain Thomas with Runnymede Lobell; William 'Bud' Fritz with Apaches Fame; William Robinson with Precious Bunny; Brett Pelling with Davids Pass; Gary Machiz with Arizona Jack; Jack Darling with Gothic Dream; Mark Ford with Gallo Blue Chip; Tim Pinske with Yankee Cruiser; Brenda Teague with Total Truth; Brent MacGrath with Sombeachsomewhere)

11 – Most starts by a trainer (William Robinson: 11-4-2-0). Robinson actually qualified 12 Cup starters but Armbro Mackintosh was a late scratch in 1994. His sons Shawn (6 starters) and Brett (3 starters) have sent out an additional 9 horses for a total of 20 different Robinson-trained starters.

9 – Trainers are undefeated in the Cup. John Hayes, Dave Wall, R. Claire Porter, Alain Thomas, William 'Bud' Fritz, Mark O'Mara, Scott McEneny, Tim Pinske and Brent MacGrath are 1-for-1.

8 – Most starts by a trainer without a win. Stew Firlotte pupils have finished 7th, 3rd, 8th, 5th, 4th, 5th, 7th and 9th.

5 – Starters sent out by Blair Burgess BEFORE he won with Tell All in 2007. That is the most of any trainer who HAS won the Cup. However, two trainers have sent out more starters WITHOUT winning the Cup: Chris Ryder (0/6), and Stew Firlotte (0/8). Bob McIntosh went into the 2012 Cup at 0/7 but won with Thinking Out Loud.

4 – Consecutive Cups won by a trainer whose first name starts with "B" (Brett Pelling in 2005, Brenda Teague in 2006, Blair Burgess in 2007 and Brent MacGrath in 2008). Casie Coleman snapped that streak when Sportswriter won in 2010 and Carl Jamieson added another "C" to the list when he won in 2011 Cup with Up The Credit, but by 2012 we were (arguably) back to the "B" trainers with Robert "Bob" McIntosh. The 2013 Cup trainers include Ben, Casie, Chris, and Colin.

In the 27 years that the Cup has been raced, and only Somebeachsomewhere, Mantacular and Sportswriter won with a “one word” name, a grand total of 9 Thoroughbreds with a “one word” name have won the Kentucky Derby (Barbaro, Giacomo, Monarchos, Charismatic, Grindstone, Unbridled, Alysheba, Ferdinand and Swale). Ironically, when Mantacular won the Cup in 2004 EACH of the top three finishers had a “one word” name as Metropolitan was second and Panspaciflight was third. Some of the better “one word” horses that failed to win the Cup have been: Guts, Astreos, Camotion, Artesian, McArdle, Riyadh, Stout, Workplace (who had the lead at the top of the stretch but broke and finished second) and Dali. In 2006 the “one word” starters were Doonbeg and Impeccable. Both made breaks. The only “one word” name in the 2007 field was Artriverderci and he drew post 10. In 2008 there were 2 starters with a one word name. Somebeachsomewhere won and Dali was 8th. In 2009 Annieswesterncard finished 9th. The 2011 Cup included Foreclosure N (4th), Eighteen (7th) and Rockabillie (9th). There were no “one word” starters in 2012. Captaintreacherous is the lone “one word” starter in 2013.

The Metro Pace

The 2011 Metro winner Simply Business squeaked into the 2012 Cup with a 5th place finish in his elimination and then finished 9th in the final. Captaintreacherous beat Odds On Equuleus by a neck to win the 2012 Metro and both horses will start in the 2013 Cup.

The Woodrow Wilson ‘Jinx’

0 – Horses have WON the Woodrow Wilson at 2 and the Cup at 3.

Dali won the 2007 Wilson and finished 8th in the 2008 Cup.

- Major In Art won the 2008 Wilson and was reportedly ready to qualify in May of 2009 but never did make a pari-mutuel start at age three.

- Windfall Blue Chip won the 2009 Wilson but failed to get another cheque at age two and skipped the Cup after finishing 8th in the Burlington.

- Fashion Delight won the 2010 Wilson but did not make a start in June of his three-year-old season.

- Major Bombay won the 2011 Wilson and finished 8th in his Cup elim and did not qualify for the final.

- Can Captaintreacherous overcome this obstacle? He won the Wilson at 2 and his Cup elim at 3.

He defeated, among others, 1908 Olympic champion John J. Hayes. In 1984 another John Hayes won the first North America Cup with Legal Notice. Finishing third in the inaugural Cup was **Long** Fella and driver **Tom** Harmer.

2 – Cup winners did NOT race at age 2 (Straight Path and Tell All)

2 – Cup starters had just 1 win going into the final (Cams Catch was 5th in 1995 and Artriverderci was 4th in 2007).

2 – Winners of The Diplomat (previously the Mohawk Series) went on to win the Cup (Tell All in 2007 and Up The Credit in 2011) **1** – Cup winner retired with a lifetime record taken on a half-mile track (Legal Notice, 1:53.3 at Delaware, OH)

2 – Date in July of the latest Cup (elims and final for the inaugural Cup were raced on the same program – Monday, July 2, 1984. The last 28 Cups have been held in June.

2 – Major highways (Don Valley Parkway and Gardiner Expressway) were closed on the night that Presidential Ball won the final Cup at Greenwood. Traffic in the downtown Toronto was chaotic. While traffic congestion wasn't a factor when the 2010 Cup was contested at Mohawk, there were numerous road closures in the

Toronto area as motorcades traveled between Pearson Airport and the downtown Toronto for the G20 Summit. **1** – Number of wins that Mantacular had from 16 starts AFTER winning the Cup. He retired after finishing 5th in the Progress Pace in November of his 3-year-old season.

2 – Geldings have won the Cup (Quite A Sensation and Gallo Blue Chip). Two geldings will start in the 2013 Cup – Vegas Vacation and Martini Hanover

1-2-3 – When Rocknroll Hanover won the Cup in 2005 it was the first Cup win for driver Brian Sears, the second for co-owner Lothlorien Equestrian, and the third for co-owner Jeffrey Snyder and trainer Brett Pelling. Lothlorien and Snyder co-owned Red River Hanover while Snyder also owned 1994 Cup champion Cams Card Shark. Pelling also won the Cup with Davids Pass in 1995 and The Panderosa in 1999.

1-1/2 – Somebeachsomewhere's smallest win margin prior to the 2008 Cup. He beat Santanna Blue Chip by 1-1/2 in the Burlington which was his 2008 debut and coming off a vet scatch (lame). **1** – Dead-Heat in Cup history (Allamerican Native & Artesian were tied for second in 2003)

0 – Number of wins that Sportswriter had after winning the Cup in 2010.

0 – Starts at age three by Warrawee Needy prior to his Cup elimination. In the past Total Truth and The Panderosa have entered the Cup elims with one start at age three. On the other end of the scale, Staff Director had 18 sophomore starts prior to his Cup elimination and 19 starts prior to his Cup win in 1985.

0 – Maidens have started in the Cup final.

Drawmasters

13 – Consecutive years in which the celebrity drawmaster had a hockey player, broadcaster or executive: Shayne Corson and Darcy Tucker (2001), Don Cherry (2002), Scotty Bowman (2003), Rick Nash (2004), Tie Domi (2005), Paul Maurice (2006), Matt Stajan (2007), Steve Stamkos (2008), Brian Burke (2009), P. K. Subban (2010), Luke Schenn (2011), Michael Del Zotto (2012) and Jake Gardiner (2013).

4 – 2012 Drawmaster Michael Del Zotto's number which was chosen in homage to Boston Bruins great Bobby Orr. When Orr was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1979 at age 31, he was the youngest to achieve that honor. 2012 elimination winner Dapper Dude was driven by John Campbell who in 1990 at age 35 became the youngest person inducted into harness racing's Hall of Fame in Goshen, NY, but he chose Post 2 in the Final and left Sweet Lou to select Post 4. They finished 3rd and 4th respectively.

Jake Gardiner Trivia

- Jake Gardiner was born July 4, 1990 – 18 days AFTER Apaches Fame won the Cup for trainer-driver Bud Fritz, thus NO trainer-driver has won the Cup during Gardiner's life.

- The only "Jake" to start in the Cup, Dr. Ken Seeber's Jake And Elwood, was 4th in the 1990 Cup – just 18 days after Jake Gardiner was born. However, Jate Lobell won the Cup in 1987, as did a pair of Jacks – Jack Darling, trainer of Gothic Dream in 1997, and Arizona Jack in 1996.

- On May 6, 2013, Gardiner became the first Toronto Maple Leaf to score a home playoff goal since Mats Sundin scored in a 3-2 loss to the Philadelphia Flyers on May 4, 2004, a span of 9 years and 2 days. Mats Sundin has never started a horse in the North America Cup but he was one of three partners who owned Rotation, winner of the \$851,500 Maple Leaf Trot at Mohawk Racetrack on Sept, 13, 2003. Earlier that year Rotation defeated Tsar D'Inverne to win the Finlandia-Ajo at the Vermo Racetrack in Helsinki, Finland Tsar D'Inverne was owned by Peter Forsberg of the Colorado Avalanche.

- The Don Valley Parkway and **Gardiner** Expressway were closed for repairs on the night Presidential Ball and Ron Waples won the last North America Cup contested at Greenwood Raceway in downtown Toronto. Traffic in the area was chaotic.
