Race 1 – Reviewed pylons on #2 Deadly Action (Brett MacDonald) in the first turn, finished 3rd – inside one pylon, no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 2 – Reviewed racing at the half – #7 The Sportsman (Ryan Desroche) causes interference to #8 Shanghai KY (Travis Henry) when moving off the rail. #7 finished 5th placed 8th. No penalty to Desroche as the horse was having steering issues.

Race 3 – Reviewed pylons on #8 Graystone Treasure (Brent Belore) past the half, finished 1st – inside one pylon, no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 6 – Reviewed racing at the top of stretch – #1 Dustylanesam (Austin Sorrie) and #3 Fine Credit (Natasha Day) hook wheels coming off the turn. The video shows both horses were at fault and as a result they caused interference to #2 Backriver Duke (Brad Moore), who was forced to swing out wide. Both horses were placed behind #2, who was moved up from 7th to 5th due to the interference.

Race 7 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #1 Hollys Treasure (Natasha Day) in the first turn, finished 2nd – inside two consecutive pylons; not lapped at wire. No violations of the AGCO pylon rule.
