Report on day's events:

Office:

- Early Veterinary scratch (sick) of BOSTON BLUE from the first race; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of UNDERCOVER STRIKE from the tenth race.

- Stephane Pouliot and Paul LaFramboise each excused from one drive.

 4. Driver of #7 MR BIG TOP, Ryan Guy, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
 5. The #2 SAULSBROOK C HORSE (Samuel Fillion) broke before the ¼ mile pole, went into the safety lane, contacted a light standard, fell, unseated the driver and ran loose;

emergency lights and siren were activated and the race declared no contest (AGCO rules 22.32.02 and 22.33); refund: \$13,623. #2 was examined by the AGCO veterinarian Dr. Melissa Rocheleau who reported the horse to be in good health; Samuel Fillion was examined by Emergency Medical Personnel, removed from his remaining drives and transported to the hospital for examination.

Cancellation fees will be paid to all starters in this race per AGCO Policy Directive No. 1-2009.

8. Driver of #8 CELIA BAYAMA, Yves Fillion, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.

Driver of #2 SHANGHAIGOLD, Steeven Genois, was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rules 22.23.01(b) (excessive action) and 22.23.03(b) (more than acceptable wrist action) in the stretch and assessed a monetary penalty of \$200 and three days driving suspension (28-30 September, inclusive) (Number 1340389). Clear.
10. Driver of #7 HAT TRICK MARLEAU, Pierre Bovay, was cautioned regarding not yielding the passing lane to the trailing horse #1 LMC MASS GEM (Jacques Beaudoin) until partially down the stretch; no placing necessary as #1 was the race winner. Clear.
